
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Section 1: Learning Objectives Assessed for this Report

The chart below outlines expectations for making adequate progress:



CSSE students were assessed using the benchmarks laid out in the graphic above. All enrolled students met the benchmarks for making adequate progress as measured by:

- Annual reviews by the student's advisor
- Completing 100 credits of coursework, with no Fs or incompletes
- Passing the comprehensive exams both in writing and in an oral defense
- Complete and successfully defend the dissertation
