In an effort to receive as much community input as possible, we are initiating a series of surveys in alignment with the Task Force deliberations on the questions the President and Provost have asked us. This first survey relates to their first question: “What is the current structure [of CAS], and what are the advantages and disadvantages of the current structure relative to the college’s ability to deliver on its teaching and research mission.”
