As a reminder, reporting your materials on time helps us comply with the statewide requirement that all Oregon colleges and universities display required course materials and associated costs on the university bookstore website at the time of student registration. Beyond complying with the legislative requirement, providing this information to students in advance of registration gives them the necessary time to find low-cost alternatives and seek financial support.
