# Quick Facts FY2017

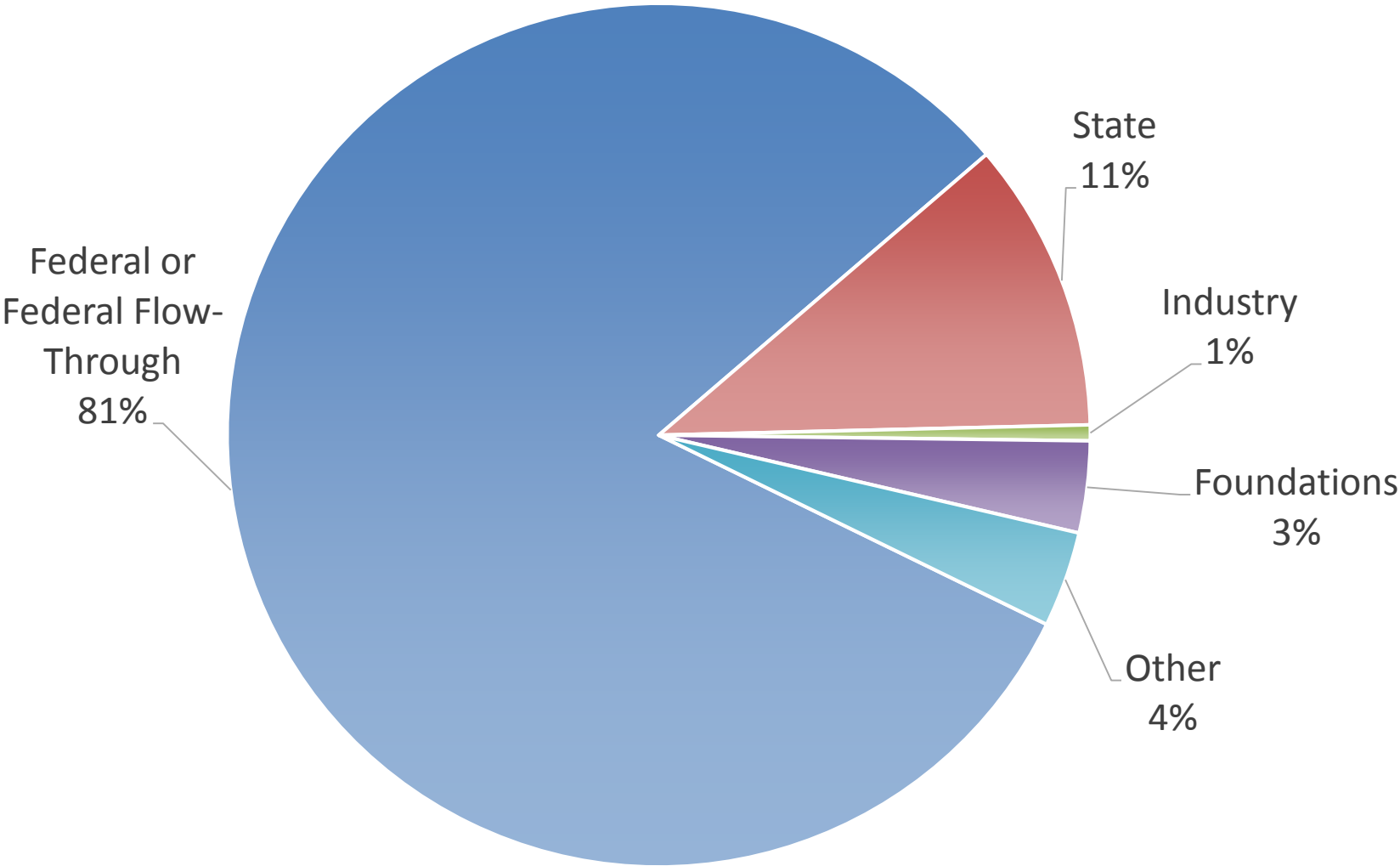
## Innovation

- \$8.86 million in licensing revenue
- \$7.73 million, or 87%, of licensing income reinvested
- 11.65% return on research through licensing
- 4 new start-up companies launched
- \$200,000 invested in IP (patents)

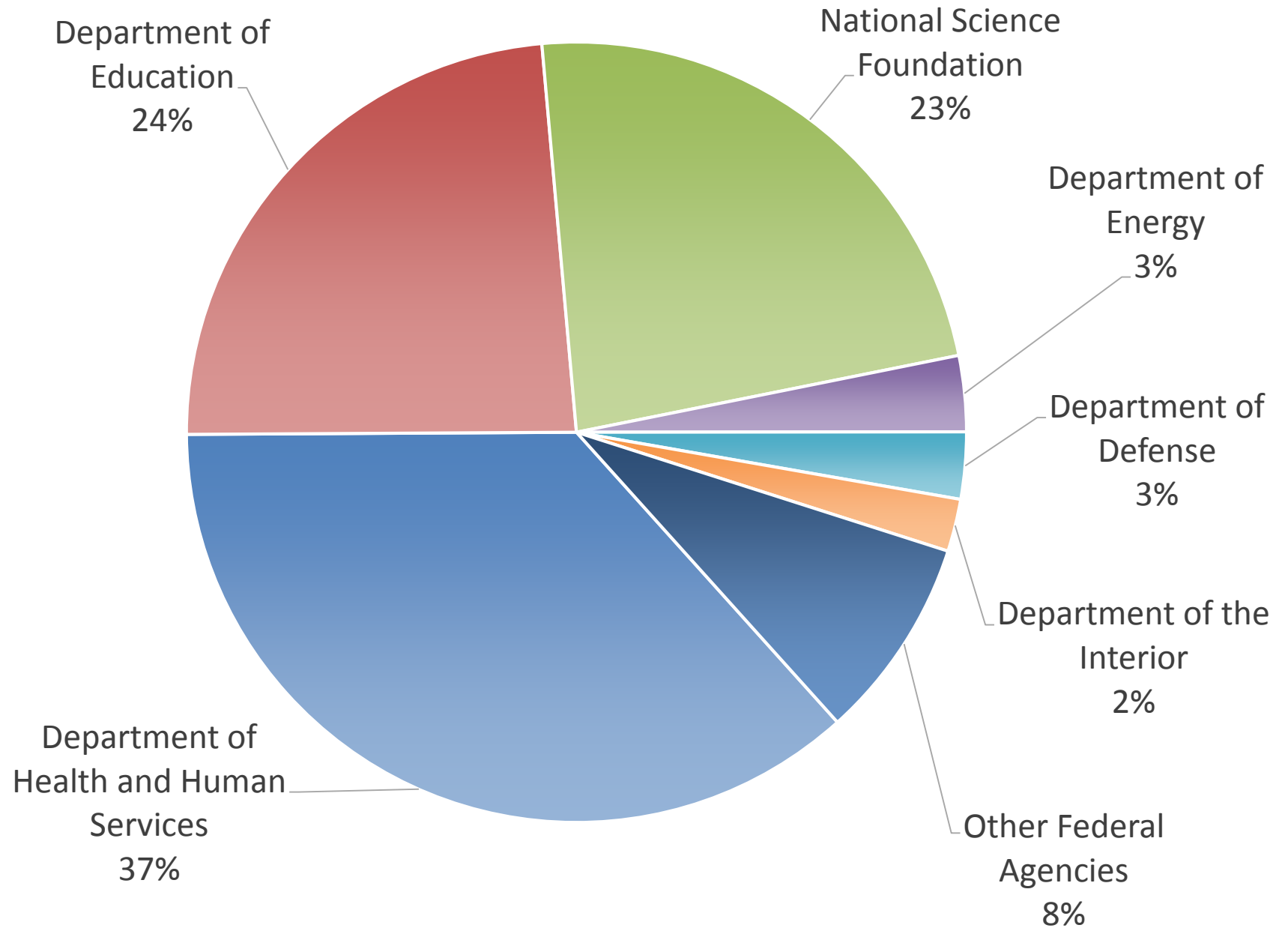
## Sponsored Funding

- \$111.1 million in sponsored expenditures

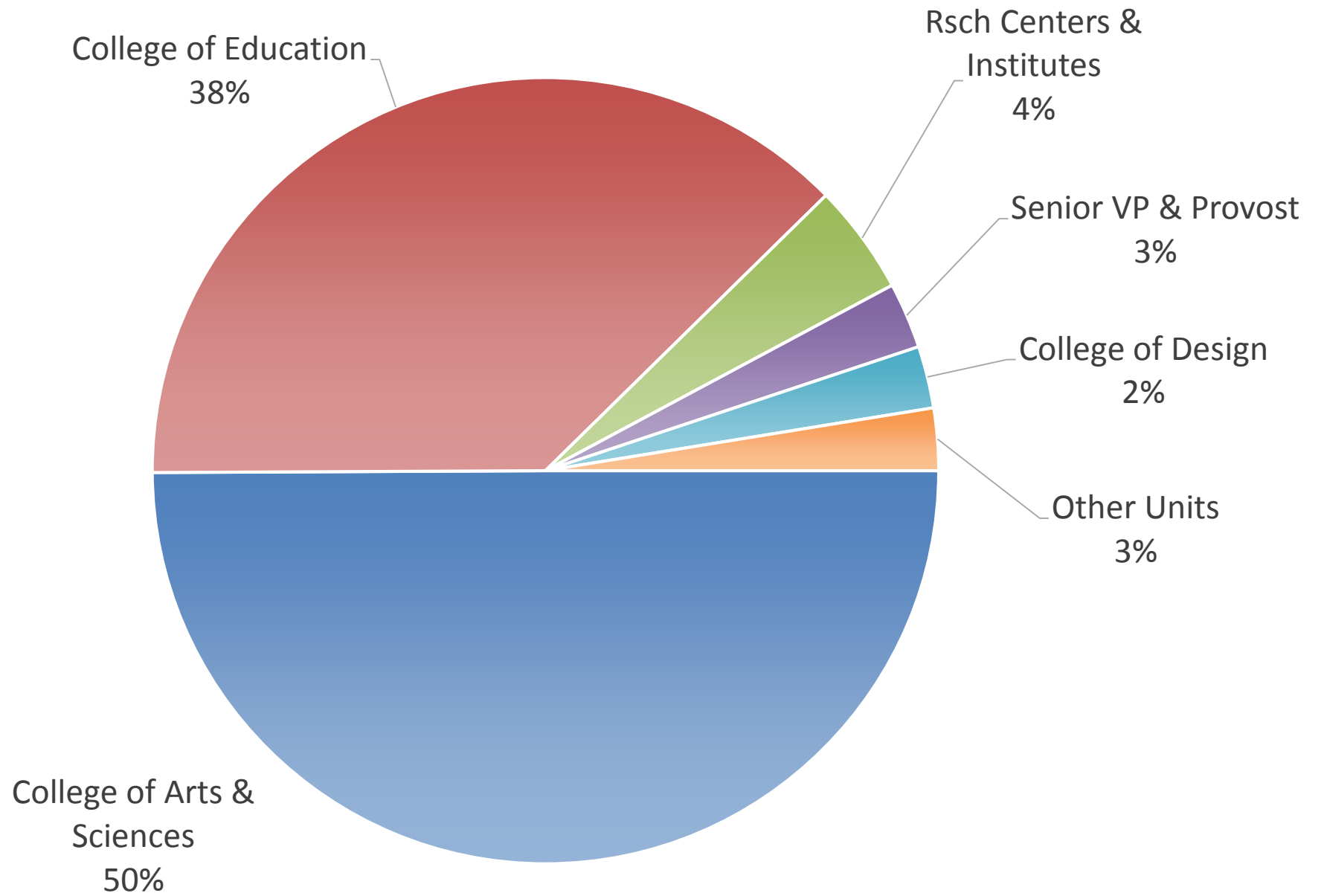
# FY2017 Total Funds Awarded by Sponsor Type

# FY2017 Awards Received by PI Home Unit





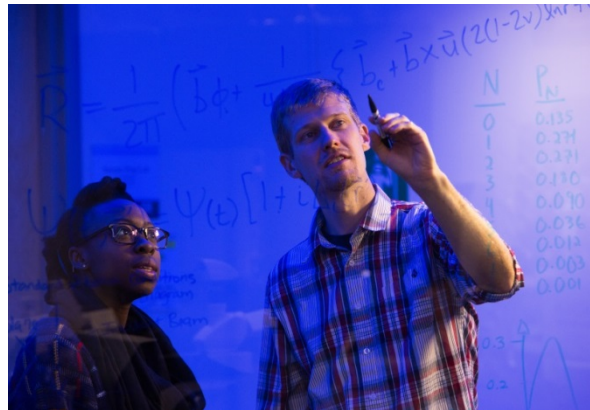

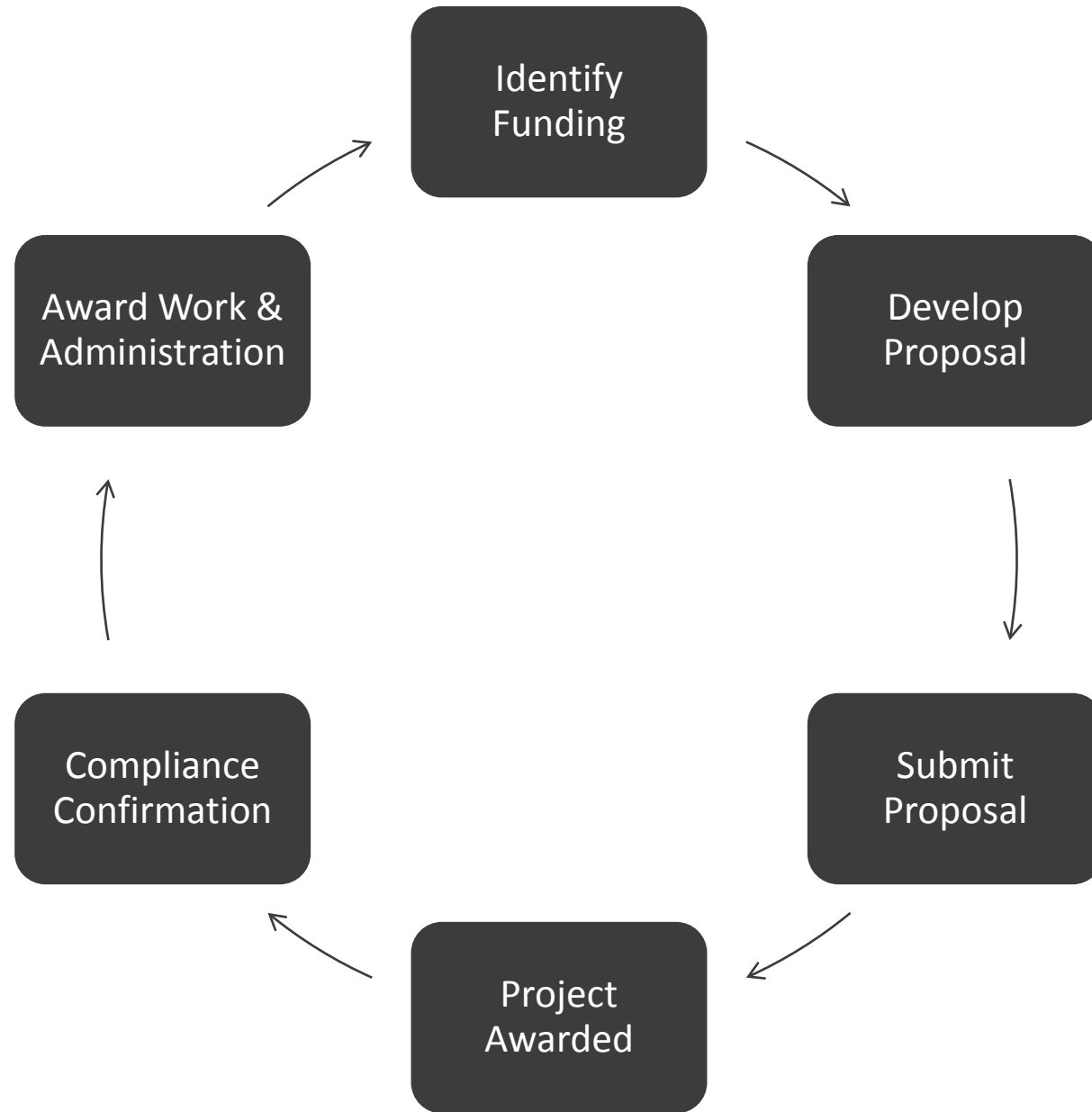
# Sponsored Awards at UO

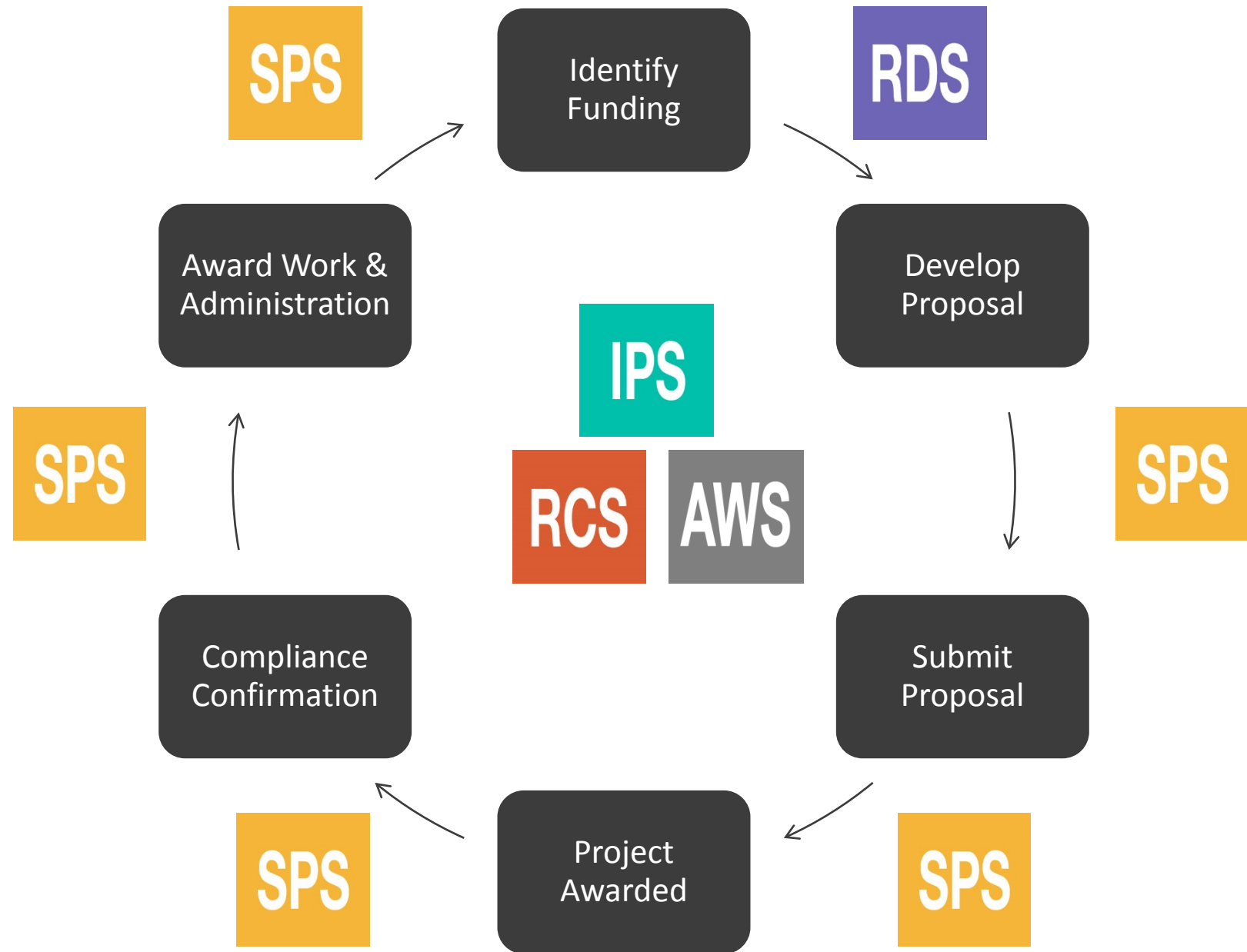
